WHEREAS there is a very close proximity and close relationship between the Municipality of L’Isle-aux-Allumettes and its surrounding communities with Ontario, specifically Renfrew County;

WHEREAS the population, the businesses and the overall economies of both L’Isle-aux-Allumettes and Renfrew County are very closely integrated;

WHEREAS there is a lack of essential services in western Pontiac to support all of its residents, including medical services, emergency services, pharmacy, grocery, banking, and other;

WHEREAS there are thousands of residents, throughout the MRC Pontiac and Renfrew County, that are required to travel across the borders for essential employment reasons;

WHEREAS the residents of this Municipality are very well-informed via various platforms and encouraged to practice all the required directives as set out by the province and the public health officials;

WHEREAS at the present time, the number of cases and the likelihood of exposure the COVID-19 virus are very similar in Renfrew County and the MRC Pontiac;

Is is therefore proposed by Councillor McGuire and unanimously resolved that this Municipality strongly oppose the comments made by Warden Jane Toller regarding the closure of the interprovincial borders; and to request that any future consideration for limited access to the region be

discussed at the local levels prior to implementation;
